The format of bibliographic and item records are changing several times – willingly or unwillingly – in the life of a library. Even when data format is preserved for decades, semantic and syntactic errors occur, not to mention data conversions. In this presentation, we will demonstrate the filtering of bibliographic and item records with the command-line filter components of the free Cinege, which was tested in the BUTE NTICL and in the Universitätsbibliothek der Freie Universität Berlin and has been developed in the BUTE NTICL.
