

## NEW DIGITAL SERVICES IN SZEGED UNIVERSITY LIBRARY

A new digital/electronic, mostly web-based, service-pack has been introduced in our library to improve research-and teaching work.

Digital Copy Request (DMI) service started on 7th November 2005, first in a smaller circle, broadening the range week after week. DMI means: the staff of the university can access to digital copies from library materials by filling in a special webform on the home-page.

The staff (researchers, teachers, and PhD students) simply give the data of the required material from the resources of our library. The document will be scanned on a MINOLTA PS7000 digital scanner.

As this service is very similar to the xerox-request, we plan to renew its request form as well.

Our 3rd new service is the so-called Mediateka. The aim is to collect TV programs, mostly docu films, rarely feature-films, which can support study and teaching. They are available in the library building, excluded from circulation and copying. (In bigger German University Libraries it is a well-functioning service)

The lecture deals with the network based background, and informatic questions of these new services in Hungary.
