

E-LIBRARY SERVICES TO SUPPORT E-LEARNING-BASED EDUCATION

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The analysis of the structure of the e-learning library and the assessment of its relationship to traditional libraries is fundamental to the effective application of e-learning. There are various solutions for interaction between library systems and e-learning systems. The majority of current solutions result from a connection of the two systems, their linkage along different aspects and requirements. It is seldom that we find an entirely e-learning-based library solution; typically, electronic documentary services are integrated into the traditional library services.

E-learning-based library interactions do not yet have a long tradition, which is due to the low level of development, or even the absence of methodological and structural elements. Among the libraries of foreign colleges and universities or other large libraries we find several examples for e-learning solutions supported by libraries. Although services reflecting an independent e-learning library structure are also uncommon among these, there are good solutions for e-learning environments integrated into the traditional library structures.
